**PROMPTS** 

This is a set of flashcards that can be used to organize the activities and games around Present Simple and Present Continuous. However you may use it to play speaking and vocabulary games with your students it will suit your needs.

Level: A1/B1

**Objective**: To study and review verbs connected with common everyday activities as well as some extended ones. The set helps you practice Present simple and Present continuous separately but also together for comparison.

The set includes:

• 219 flashcards - images with different activities and prompts

The prompts are mixed but you can sort them out to create two decks cards to play tense comparison with your students. You can also just pratice Present Simple or Present Continuous separately to stress the difference between them.

## Instructions:

T puts the mixed up flashcards upside down in two piles. Ss sit in groups (3-5 players) and the first S takes one ard from each pile. Based on the pictures and/or T's instructions the S may create present simple or present continuous sentence.

Feel free to use the flashcards any way you want that suits the needs of your students.
